Captain Certification - \$895 *

- Steering under both power and sail

- Sails and roller furling systems
- Understanding sail trim

Crew Certification - \$745

- Basic boat systems and terminology
- Basics of docking, line handling and knots
- Sailing principles and points of sail
- Steering under power and sail
- Interpret charts and use GPS
- Practice anchoring
- Practice safety and emergency exercises
